Every year we care for over 20,000 animals at the Auckland SPCA. We provide food, shelter and our total love and attention to those animals who come into our care and we do our best to find them loving, permanent homes.

Many of the animals who arrive at our shelter have been neglected, physically abused or abandoned by their owners, and the cost of rescuing, treating and rehabilitating them is simply enormous.

We believe education is the key to ending animal cruelty. That's why we work closely with Auckland schools and community groups in order to ensure that today's children grow up with

empathy and respect for all animals as well as for each other.

The Auckland SPCA education program reaches over 15,000 children and adults every year. It encourages compassion and responsible behaviour and offers the opportunity to interact with not only cats and dogs, but also our resident farm animals.

HOPE[®] for justice

Every day, the Auckland SPCA team of Inspectors is faced with horrific cases of animal abuse and neglect. They are extraordinary people who risk their own safety to ensure the safety of animals and often have to act as law enforcers, teachers, negotiators and counsellors.

When faced with a deliberate act of cruelty the Auckland SPCA will always endeavour to prosecute the offender to seek justice. Taking a case to court is time-consuming and often costs thousands of dollars - this is completely funded by the Auckland SPCA.

We receive no automatic government funding and no local authority funding. All the work we do is primarily funded by public donations and some grants and sponsorships.

Giving HOPE®

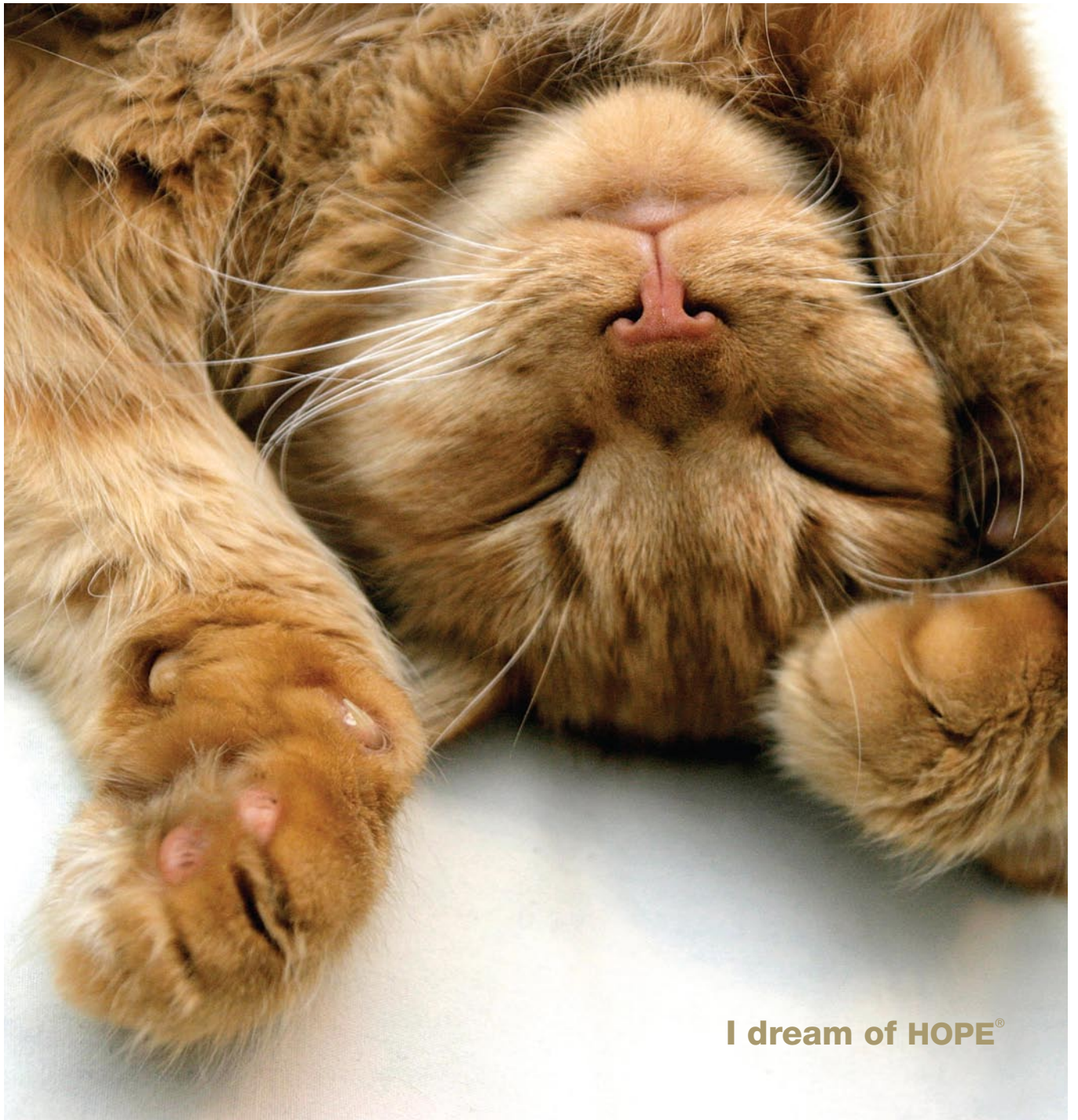
